Thurrock Council Secondary School Admissions

If your child has just started the last year of primary education (currently in Year 6), you must now apply for a Secondary school place for September 2023.

Apply online from 1st September at Thurrock.gov.uk/admissions

go to Thurrock.gov.uk/admissions and select 'Secondary school admissions'. You will be able to open an online copy of the prospectus for Thurrock primary schools, booklet

called **Secondary Admission Information September 2023**, which you should read carefully before applying.

You must have an email account to apply online. You should also try to join online at one of the briefing sessions before you complete an application.

Three briefing sessions for parents will be held on Thursday
15 September 2022 via webinar on the council website.

Go to thurrock.gov.uk/admissions and select 'Secondary school admissions' to access the webinar.

Offers will be available for applicants via your online account from 12:30am on 1 March 2023.

If you do not complete the application and do not return it by the closing date of 31 October 2022 you may be given a place at the nearest school with a space available, after all on-time applications have been dealt with. Parking


