Dear Parents/Carers

Year 6 Educational Visit - Warner Brothers Studio Tour - Wednesday 17th April 2024

At Giffards, we are constantly striving to provide creative, inspiring experiences for our children in order to stimulate and enrich their learning. We have planned an exciting trip to Warner Brothers Studio, which is a behind the scenes tour immersing children into the world of Harry Potter. Our aim is to provide the children with first hand experiences that they can apply to the work we will do on the return to class. The visit will take place on **Wednesday 17th April 2024**. The coach will leave school by **8.30am** and we will return to school at approximately **4.30pm**. The children will need to be in school by **8.15am** for registration. **Children should enter by the usual gate and go straight to the KS2 Hall for registration purposes.**

The school has managed to secure an educationally discounted entrance rate, so the total cost of the visit including transport, will be £28.85. We appreciate this may seem expensive but this is a fantastic opportunity for the children and it always proves to be a very exciting and worthwhile visit. No child will be omitted if parents are unable to pay, but clearly, the visit will not take place if parents do not support it.

With this in mind, we will offer parents the opportunity to pay for this trip in instalments. We will require £10 non-refundable deposit unless the trip is cancelled due to lack of support by Friday 5th January 2024. This will be followed by 2 payments of £6.28 by Friday 2nd February 2024 and Friday 1st March 2024 with a final payment of £6.29 by Thursday 28th March 2024.

Please arrange payment via your child's SCOPAY account ensuring all permissions and questions regarding collection of your child are completed.

The children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch and a drink, preferably in a carton or plastic container and not in a glass or other fragile bottle. If your child is eligible for FSM (Free School Meals), a packed lunch can be ordered via your child's SCOPAY account by Friday 22nd March 2024, orders cannot be taken after this date.

Your child's place on this trip is dependent on consistent good behaviour and high attendance throughout the school year. In line with our School Visits Policy we reserve the right to disallow any pupil from a school trip if their negative behaviour is or could be deemed to put the Health and Safety of other pupils and school staff at risk.
