General Information:

Please ensure your child's uniform and PE kit are clearly named. On your child's PE day, please ensure that earnings are removed for Health and Safety reasons or the children have tape in school. Please ensure this is black shorts and jogging bottoms, white t-shirt or polo shirt and a black jacket or jumper.

PE for each class will be on a Wednesday when the children need to come into school wearing their PE kit. Their additional PE is on a Thursday when they will get changed into their PE kit kept in school.

Homework:

- Reading This needs to be at least three times a week for fifteen to twenty minutes and recorded in the reading diaries.
- Times tables These should be practiced on a daily basis using Times Table Rock Stars for a minimum of thirty minutes a week.
- Spellings Children will be given spellings to learn each week, these will be stuck into their reading records. A spelling activity can be accessed from each Friday via Spelling Shed to help them learn their spellings. Spellings should be learnt for the test the following Friday.

English In the first half term we will be exploring 'Cinderella of the Nile'. Children will explore character emotions to write a diary and once they have read the text they will then devise their own version of the story complete with fable. In the second half of the term we will be exploring 'Black Dog'. Children will write their own story with suspense based on a fear they might have, using the structure of	Maths The children will be learning about fractions including: understanding denominators and numerators, comparing and ordering fractions, counting in fractions on a number line and finding equivalent fractions. The children will learn about mass and capacity: use scales, measure in grams and kilograms, compare mass, add and subtracts masses and measure and compare capacity.
Black Dog. Music The children will be listening to the music by Antonio Vivaldi and John Sousa. They will name the style of music composed. They will use musical vocabulary to identify similarities and differences.
