General Information:

- Spelling A list of words will be sent home with your child on a Friday. These are to be practised and learnt. There will be a test on these words. Additional games and activities are available on Spelling Shed for children to use if they wish. Passwords are in your children reading record.
- Times tables Children should try and complete 30 minutes on TTRS across the week (5 minutes a day). By the end of Year 4 children should know all tables up to and including 12x12. During the year, there will be 'Battles' on TTRS for the children to compete in.
- Maths No regular work will be set. Additional games and activities are available on Maths Shed for children to access and complete if they wish. Passwords are in your child's reading record.

We are encouraging the children to become more independent by following the 5Rs of readiness, resilience, resourcefulness, responsibility and reflectiveness, so please remind your child that it is their responsibility to do their homework and have their reading records in school every day.
